## **Short Term Scientific Missions**

## What is a Short-Term Scientific Mission (STSM)?

\* aim of STSM is to contribute to the scientific objectives of a COST Action. aim at strengthening the existing COST Actions by allowing scientists to go to an institution or laboratory in another COST country to foster collaboration, to learn a new schnique or to take measurements using instruments and/or methods of available in their own institution/laboratory. They are particularly intended for young scientists

Period: min. 5 working days and max. 3 months For ESRs up to 6 months

max. contribution for a mission 3 months is 2000 Euros or up to 6 months and 3500 Euros for ESRs. The financial support is a fixed contribution to the costs of a STSM and may not necessarily cover all the costs.

## Who can apply?

- \* Undergraduate students, PhD-students, early stage researchers, Researchers with their lab in one of the current member states of this COST Action. This institution shall be actively participating in the COST Action.
- \* Researchers with a proposal related to the topic of this COST Action
